



SRA Regulatory Breaches Register

What is an SRA Regulatory Breaches Register?

The SRA Regulatory Breaches Register is intended to record actual and suspected SRA breaches, which will help you to identify patterns of issues in the firm.

Why do firms need an SRA Regulatory Breaches Register?

All firms have a duty to report serious concerns or breaches of the SRA Codes of Conduct promptly. Law firm employees should tell a firm's compliance officer for legal practice (COLP) about any concerns. The COLP will then make a professional judgement on whether to report these concerns to the SRA.

What type of information should be maintained in an SRA Regulatory Breaches Register?

All SRA related breaches should be added to the register as they are discovered by employees. The register should note which rule has been breached, the matter number, the relevant dates and amounts, and how the breach has been corrected. It should also note whether the breach is considered 'material' or not, and how this conclusion was reached.

How should firms use the data in the SRA Regulatory Breaches Register?

In addition to providing the necessary breach information to the SRA, the SRA Regulatory Breaches Register should be used as a tool to identify risk areas highlighted by trends in breaches, either by type, by department or by employee.

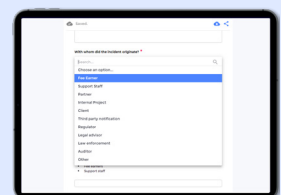
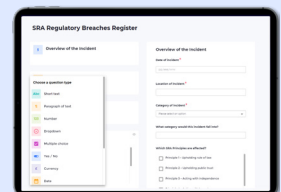
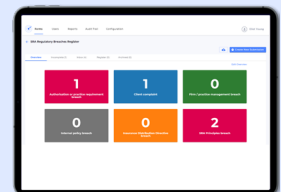
